Honey Lane, Otham
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2023

To allow excavation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Honey Lane, Otham.

A closure is planned from 7th March 2023, with estimated completion by 10th March 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (EB00934122776-01 - South East Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Honey Lane will be closed outside the verge adjacent to Buglehorn Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while excavation works are undertaken by South East Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Honey Lane, New Road, A274 Sutton Road, Gore Court Road, White Horse Lane and vice versa.
